Comment nous trouver

Les expositions de la Galerie Schlassgoart ont lieu dans les locaux du Pavillon du Centenaire situé dans les «Nonnewisen» près du Boulevard Grande-Duchesse Charlotte à Esch-sur-Alzette. Il n'y a pas de places de parking boulevard Grande-Duchesse Charlotte.

Nous recommandons au visiteur venant de Luxembourg de prendre la sortie 5 vers Esch-sur-Alzette, rue de Luxembourg. Arrivé au feu rouge (église à droite, station d'essence à gauche) continuer tout droit sur la rue de Luxembourg sur +/- 200m et tourner à droite dans la rue Jean-Pierre Michels (direction Centre Hospitalier-CHEM). Continuer tout droit sur +/- 700m. Arrivé près de l'hôpital, continuer toujours tout droit sur +/- 100m et tourner à droite dans la rue Nicolas Biever. Au bout de cette rue se trouvent de nombreuses places de Parking. Emprunter le passage pour piétons Boulevard Grande-Duchesse Charlotte pour rejoindre la Galerie Schlassgoart.



Culture for Future

The year 2024 marks the 10th anniversary of Plooschter Projet a.s.b.l. Culture for Future highlights this important milestone in the story of the association.

Culture for Future is a fundraising exhibition showcasing the work of twenty-one emerging visual artists with ties to Luxembourg. Their practices range from painting to sculpture, illustration, and photography. The group show at pavillon du centenaire of Schlassgoart gallery features strong and diverse positions of young creators who have an impact on today's Luxembourgish art production, both locally and internationally.

Gilles Weidig and Sandra Lieners are board members of Plooschter Projet and the main organizers and curators of Culture for Future. They share a common concern and interest for cancer research and contemporary art alike. Their aim is to further underline the importance of Plooschter Projet's cause among the Luxembourgish public and to support the local art scene as well as medical research.

The proceeds gathered via the artwork sales will support leukemia research projects by their partner LIH – Luxembourg Institute of Health. In the past, donations from Plooschter Projet towards them funded the groundbreaking project by Etienne Moussay and Jérôme Paggetti: "Characterization of T cells in the microenvironment of chronic lymphocytic leukemia" (TIME-CLL).

Besides the visual art showcase, the framework program includes a stem cell donor registration event by Plooschter Projet on the premises of Schlassgoart gallery. The event is accompanied by a live concert of the Luxembourgish duo ENGLBRT, founded in 2023 by musicians Niels Engel and Georges Goerens.
